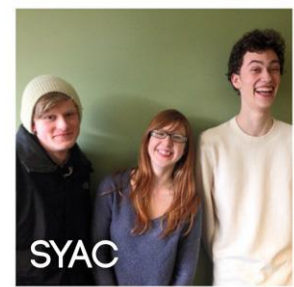


YOUTH VOICES
